Fire Safety in Yard Checklist

The following is a checklist of fire prevention tasks around your property.

Use the boxes to the left of the items to check off tasks as you complete them.

☐ Ladder fuel reduction. Prune trees to above 3 times the height of growing under the tree's drip line.	of the vegetation
☐ Either chip and spread over the area or haul off site all debris created from the fuel reduction work	
☐ Do not "top" trees.	
□ Establish a 30" primary fuel break around your home or building:	
* Remove all dead material located on or overhanging roofs and any portion of trees within 10' of chimney.	
□ * Clean out gutters.	a free
* Clear all flammable material from beneath decks and stairways, including firewood and lumber.	
□ * Ground cover should be substantially non-flammable.	
□ * Dry grass should be cut to a height of less than 4".	
* Cut grass, leaves, needles, twigs, and other small vegetative debris should be broken up.	
* Shrubs and trees should be maintained in a green condition, free of dead plant materials.	
* Shrubs and trees should be spaced so that fire cannot spread from plant to plant.	
* Driveways longer than 150' need clearance to allow for emergency access should be required.
